- Evidence of at least four years of practicing psychotherapy as a licensed/registered practitioner, whereby one year is the equivalent of a minimum of 20 contact hours per week, attested to by your supervisor;
- Evidence of a regular full membership, of not less than four years with a recognized national association for the modality that the applicant comes from or from other related and recognized associations, such as the EAP or the EAGT;
